#### FINANCIAL REPORT:

Garry Csapos presented the financial report showing prepaid and unpaid bills of \$9,903.48 for October 2024. A Trial Balance report from the Shiawassee County Financial Administrator shows a pooled cash balance of \$46,824.82 in Horizon and \$25,277.40 in Chase ending September 30th, 2024. The AvFuel credit balance ending September 30th, 2024 was \$89,123.76. Total revenue deposited for the month of September 2024 was \$5,775.00. #### **MANAGERS REPORT:**

Garry Csapos reported that fuel sales for the month September 2024 is 3,802 gallons. Total fuel sales so far for the year 2024 is 30,961 gallons. On Monday September 16<sup>th</sup> Weinert's Tree Service trimmed the trees in the approach to runway 24. On September 17<sup>th</sup> I updated the Owosso Community Airport Directory page for the 2025 Michigan Airport Directory and e-mailed it to MDOT Aeronautics. On Tuesday September 17<sup>th</sup> I texted Stephenie Whitinger, our MDOT Aeronautics Aviation Inspector a picture of the runway 24 approach after all of the tree trimming had been completed. The airport manager will be a featured speaker at the Shiawassee Regional Chamber of Commerce Chamber a.m. breakfast December 10<sup>th</sup> 2024. On Wednesday October 2<sup>nd</sup> the airport started receiving donated items for delivery to the hurricane relief effort. On Friday October 4<sup>th</sup> Summit Fire Protection inspected all of the fire extinguishers and they all checked out OK. We need to update the NOTAM Authorization list and a thank you goes out to Mona Lisa McLaughlin for her efforts in organizing the Hurricane relief effort at the airport.
